



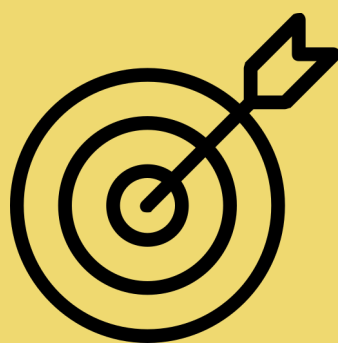

Activities
