

COMPASS PILOTING RESULTS

LAST NEWSLETTER

The COMPASS project has reached its final stage, with piloting activities taking place in all countries of the consortium.

These activities tested the quality of the materials developed in the IO2 - Competences-based Youth Workers' Training Programme and in the IO4 - Gamified platform for NEETs activation and empowerment.

The results and feedback received from the more than 10 activities carried out at international level and from the more than 150 people who participated were highly positive, highlighting the usefulness, quality, design and dynamism of the materials.



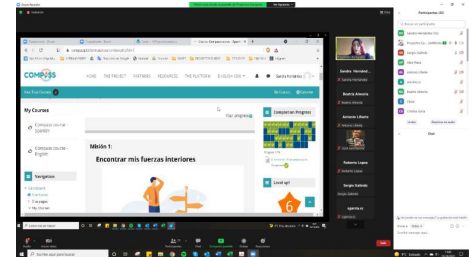
Based on that, we can conclude that the materials developed in the COMPASS project are suitable for use and application in the field of NEETs and youth work.

Let's take a look on each partner's activities and contribution to the final step of the project.



Spain

Two online activities were held in Spain. Acción Laboral tested the IO2 Training Kit materials with 12 Youth professionals (workers, trainers and counsellors) and the IO4 platform with more than 30 people (counsellors, trainers, youngsters, unemployed people) with a huge success.

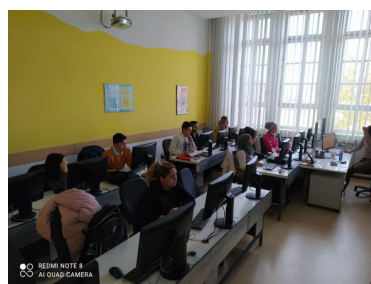


Bulgaria

Two activities were held in Bulgaria too. CATRO met more than 40 youth workers and mediators from the Employment Agency with NEETs counselling experience to test the IO2 Training Kit materials and its exercises in fruitful and dynamic sessions during 2021 summer.

Austria

In Austria, OJAB conducted workshops for the Training Kit (IO2) with trainers, educators and youth workers. Furthermore, OJAB conducted 4 piloting workshops with young people where the gamified platform (IO4) was tested. The gamified platform is constantly used in several courses conducted by OJAB as it can be used in highly varying settings.



France

In France the pilot testing of the Training kit and the platform have been conducted during two Multiplier events, at the adult training centre AFPA at Bayonne and at the employment insertion centre IEBA at Morlaas. During the two half day events, the results of the COMPASS project were presented to a group of youth workers, stakeholders, and young NEETs. This mixed composition of the audience allowed to present both outputs and to discuss them extensively.



Romania

Different activities were held in Romania by Predict Consulting. In them, the satisfaction was generally high as the Training Kit is very useful for youth workers and teachers, youth leaders, it is well documented, clear and easy to use.

Greece

A face-to-face activity was held in Greece, where the University of Thessaly presented the materials developed in the project, both the Competences-based Youth Workers' Training Programme and the Gamified Platform for NEETs activation and empowerment.
